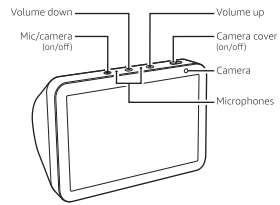


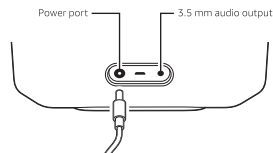
## Getting to know your Echo Show 8



Also included: Power adapter

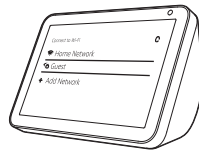
## 1. Plug in your Echo Show 8

Plug your Echo Show 8 into an outlet using the included power adapter. In about a minute, the display will turn on and Alexa will greet you.



## 2. Set up your Echo Show 8

Follow the on-screen instruction to set up your Echo Show 8. During setup, you will connect your Echo Show 8 to the internet so you can access Amazon services. Please make sure you have your Wi-Fi password.

## 3. Getting started with your Echo Show 8

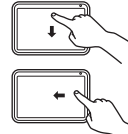
### Interacting with your Echo Show 8

- To power your Echo Show 8 on and off, press and hold the mic/camera button.
- To turn off the microphones and camera, press and release the mic/camera button. The LED will turn red.
- To cover the camera, slide the built-in shutter.
- You can use your Echo Show 8 via voice commands or using the touchscreen.

### To change your settings

To access Settings, swipe down from the top of the screen, or say, "Alexa, show Settings."

To access your shortcuts, swipe left from the right side of the screen.



## Things to try with your Echo Show 8

### Watch TV shows, movies, videos and photos

Alexa, start watching *The Grand Tour*.  
Alexa, show my photos from Hawaii.

### Enjoy your favorite music and audio books

Alexa, play a rock music playlist.  
Alexa, resume my audiobook.

### Get answers to your questions

Alexa, how tall is Mt. Everest?  
Alexa, what can you do?

### Get news, podcasts, weather, and sports

Alexa, tell me the news.  
Alexa, show me the weekend weather forecast.

### Voice control your smart home

Alexa, show the front door camera.  
Alexa, turn off the lamp.

### Stay connected

Alexa, drop in on the family room.  
Alexa, drop in on the family room.
